

Student Travel Support for VRST 2017

VRST 2017 conference

The ACM Symposium on Virtual Reality Software and Technology (VRST) is an international forum for the exchange of experience and knowledge among researchers and developers concerned with virtual reality software and technology. The conference will be hosted by the Department of Computer Science and Engineering at Chalmers University of Technology, Gothenburg, Sweden, 08-10 November 2017.

Purpose

The essential purpose of this funding application is to fund international students speakers to be able to attend the conference.

We have been made aware that there are student authors of accepted papers that will be unable to attend the conference as it currently stands. The travel support applied for here would be used to cover hotel and travel costs for students who are speaking at the conference, but who have insufficient funds to attend the meeting.

Having a diverse set of international students is a high priority for VRST and we would appreciate the possibility to use this grant to ensure that all accepted student authors have the possibility to attend the conference.

Total cost applied for, 3 students: 3600 EUR

VRST 2017 will cover the conference registration fee for these students.
